Dan consults on product development of life insurance and annuities, as well as New York and SEC compliance issues. He has been involved in a wide range of projects related to private placement variable life, both onshore and offshore. Other assignments have included IRC Section 7702 compliance review, reinsurance, assisting companies analyze exposure and value proposed settlements under market conduct class action.
